This cassette is a radio show recorded on **WAPS FM 91.3 (91-3 The Summit)** in Akron, Ohio on May 16, 1999. The show was brought up live before sound check was complete, and the mix is very weak, but there are some great moments here.

Picks: 007 / Goldfinger, Town Without Pity, Perry Mason

"007 / Goldfinger" [live radio] ★★☆☆

This is just as cool as the rehearsal tape. Less edgie, more fluid. The band is showing their articulate playing here. Some tasty variations and inventions. This is from the sound check.

Film Theme Instrumental Stereo

"Secret Agent Man" [live radio] ★★☆☆

You can almost see **Patrick Magoohan** running from the evil empire's henchmen. Edgier than the **Johnny Rivers** theme to the US distribution of the British series **Danger Man**, this holds up well, rendering a timeless accounting of the stealth world of spies and mysterious goings on. **Phil Sloane's** TV theme is done with less lounge and more of a country-rock sound.

Lounge Surf Instrumental Stereo

"Penetration" [live radio] ★★☆☆

Nearly as big as the demo... the shortcoming is the radio mix with too much drums, but the performance is powerful.

Surf Instrumental Stereo

"Town Without Pity" [live radio] ★★☆☆

What a cool tune to do instrumentally. The lead is lost in the mix under too much keyboard, but the idea is brilliant. It finally gets up some in the mix 'bout halfway through. The noodling filigrees on lead make this even cheesier than it is... great!

Teen Pop Surf Instrumental Stereo

"Perry Mason" [live radio] ★★☆☆

Just fun... pass the cheese plate, mama, the TV's in black and white and **Hamilton Burger** is losing another case to PM! Great piano work, and very jazzy guitar. Suave and debonair.

TV Theme Instrumental Stereo

"Experiment In Terror" [live radio] ★★☆☆

Semi rockin' slightly cheese ball interpretation of this classic **Mancini** tune. Both suave and gutsy. Aside from too much drums and not enough guitar, this is a fun track.

Film Theme Instrumental Stereo

"Beach Police" [live radio] ★★★

Not sure of the title... this is a fifties jazzy combo piece with organ lead and a **Jimmy Smith** feel.

Beach Jazz Instrumental Stereo

"Shot In The Dark" [live radio] ★★★

Ultra cheesy organ interpretation of the film theme. The vibes (keyboards) sound very cool... lounge and martini inspired.

Film Theme Instrumental Stereo

"Mission Impossible" [live radio] ★★★

Relatively accurate portrayal of the spy show theme... bouncy and fun without pretense.

TV Theme Instrumental Stereo

"Munsters Theme" [live radio] ★★★

Vic Mizzy's monster tune done with guitar lead in a modern style. The duet with the organ is kinda cool... it's a short arrangement that seques into "**Hawaii 5-0.**"

TV Theme Instrumental Stereo

"Hawaii 5-0" [live radio] ★★★

Nothing like the show theme, and unlike the **Ventures** hit as well. It does have a TV theme feel and sound. Fun.

TV Theme Instrumental Stereo

"Telstar" [live radio] ★★★

Cheesy to the max... not thick like the Tornadoes, but with the organ lead, it certainly has the feel... the jazzy guitar adds a sense of proper society to this classic **Joe Meek** tune.
